
Guide to Completing NZ Fire Doors Detail Sheet



1) Door ID / Fire Rating

Document the door number and Fire Rating (Obtained from Fire Engineers Report / Plans) unique ID required for each door.

2) Door Leaf Details

Document the finish, supply measurements and specify if leaf or trim sizes have been supplied.

3) Jamb Detail

Profile - select from profiles offered for timber & steel at the bottom of detail sheet.

Finish - Document the finish required.

4) Wall Construction

Document thickness of wall, only total finished wall thickness is required unless T2 or T3 are selected If T2 or T3 are selected full wall details are required (Stud & linings per HS / NHS).

For steel jambs please also select wall construction to ensure correct fixings are prepared in jamb.

5) Hanging Detail

Document if LH/RH or Pair hanging detail is required. In a pair, if meeting stile is rebated or hardware preparation is required the Active leaf must be specified!

6) Hardware Details

This detail is required for steel frames (retro fitting strike plates is extremely difficult)! If leaf prep is required type and placement / height is required.

7) VP/Sidelight

Note if vision panel or sidelight is required. If multiple please supply rough sketch.

8) Vision Panel / Grille Details

Provide measurements and confirm glass type, cutout or clear view size and placement in the leaf.

9) Special Instructions

Any extra detail important to the correct manufacture.

^{*} Extra cost may be incurred if any manufacturing details differ from original quote.

^{**} NZFD hand their doors by looking at the knuckle of the hinge when the door is closed, i.e. if you can see the silver round part of the hinge on the left hand side it is a left hand hung door.
